WHEREAS, the Parking Authority City of Camden shall charge a sum of twelve dollars (\$12.00) per bus of which the Authority shall pay to the Owner the sum of \$3.85, consisting of \$3.35 per vehicle and \$0.84 for the 7% State parking tax to be remitted by Owner; therefore retaining the sum of \$7.81 per vehicle.

WHEREAS, the term of this contract shall commence during the 2015 baseball season and shall expire at the end of the 2015 baseball season; now
