WHEREAS, the adopted Annual Budget as presented for adoption reflects Total Revenues of \$4,440,355, Total Appropriations, including any Accumulated Deficit, if any, of \$4,415,048 and Total Unrestricted Net Assets utilized of \$210,240; and

WHEREAS, the adopted Capital Budget as presented for adoption reflects Total Capital Appropriations of \$4,603,715 and Total Unrestricted Net Assets planned to be utilized of \$4,603,715; and
