THE PARKING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF CAMDEN AUTHORIZING A REDEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PARKING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF CAMDEN AND THE CITY OF CAMDEN REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Camden Redevelopment Agency, a body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, organized pursuant to the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1, et seq. (the "Redevelopment Law"), owns those nine (9) parcels of land (and such improvements and facilities situate thereon) identified on <u>Schedule A</u> attached hereto and made a part hereof (collectively, the "Lots"); and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Camden, in furtherance of its plans for the revitalization of the City of Camden, adopted by Ordinance MC-4086, pursuant to the Redevelopment Law, a redevelopment plan that includes the Lots; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Parking Authority of the City of Camden has the experience, skill, financial ability and expertise to develop and construct the project described in the Redevelopment Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agreement and the transactions contemplated thereby will significantly benefit the City of Camden by fostering the goal of redevelopment under the Redevelopment Plan, including utilization of the Lots and the creation of additional value to the other portions of the areas covered by the Redevelopment Plan by fostering additional development thereon; and

WHEREAS, the Parking Authority of the City of Camden wishes to enter into, and perform its obligations under, the Redevelopment Agreement, on the terms and conditions set forth therein.
