GLOSSARY

The following definitions shall apply to and are used in this Request for Qualifications:

"Parking Authority" - refers to the Parking Authority of the City of Camden.

"Qualification Statement" - refers to the complete responses to this RFQ submitted by the Respondents.

"Qualified Respondent" - refers to those Respondents who (in the sole judgment of the Parking Authority) have satisfied the qualification criteria set forth in this RFQ.

"RFQ" - refers to this Request for Qualifications, including any amendments thereof or supplements thereto.

"Respondent" or "Respondents" - refers to the interested firm(s) that submit a Qualification Statement.

INTRODUCTION AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1. Introduction and Purpose.

The City of Camden, New Jersey is a city on the rise. The city is beginning to experience new vitality, attracting new businesses, encouraging the expansion of the higher education centers, supporting the expansion of the medical institutions, and developing the waterfront entertainment district. This recent growth has created the need for new parking facilities to meet the increasing demand.

To that end, the City is considering the design and construction of a parking garage to be located at the intersection of Federal Street and Broadway. This garage will be 6 tiers tall, and accommodate approximately 740 cars. The ground level of the garage will also provide approximately 15,500 square feet of retail/office shell space for future development, to front Federal Street and Broadway. Vehicle entrance into the garage will be from Hudson Street, opposite the new Rutgers School of Nursing.

The Parking Authority is soliciting Qualification Statements from interested firms that can provide Parking Structure Geotechnical Engineering Services.

Through a Request for Qualification process described herein, persons and/or firms interested in assisting the Parking Authority with the provision of such services must prepare and submit a Qualification Statement in accordance with the procedure and schedule in this RFQ. The Parking Authority will review Qualification Statements only from those firms that submit a Qualification Statement which includes all the information required to be included as described herein (in the sole judgment of the Parking Authority). The Parking Authority intends to qualify person(s) and/or firm(s) that (a) possesses the professional, financial and administrative capabilities to provide the proposed services, and (b) will agree to work under the compensation terms and conditions determined by the Parking Authority to provide the greatest benefit to the residents of Camden.

1.2 <u>Background Information</u>

The PACC is requesting proposals from experienced and qualified firms to provide Geotechnical Engineering Services for the PACCs Block N Parking Structure Project in connection with the following:

The Block N Parking Structure will be constructed in the City of Camden, NJ, identified as Block N. The garage is a 6 tier, 3-bay, single-threaded helix providing approximately 740 spaces. The ramp is located in the center bay. Additionally, a retail/office of approximately 15,500 square feet is provided on the ground level, fronting Federal Street and Broadway. Approximately 13,500 SF of retail/office area will remain as a

"shell", while approximately 2,000 SF will be improved to habitable space as part of this project.

The footprint is approximately 45,000 SF +/- for 6 levels. The foundations will be on drilled piers. The ground tier will consist of a 5" thick slab-on-grade and the upper tiers will consist of precast concrete. There will be two (2) elevator/stair towers. The main tower in the southwest corner will support two (2) elevator cabs, while the secondary tower in the northeast corner will support one (1) elevator cab. The towers will be designed to maximize glazing, to promote passive security. The parking structure shall be considered open per code – not requiring mechanical ventilation or fire suppression system. Energy-efficient, LED lighting with occupancy sensors and bi-level dimming are anticipated. CCTV will be provided at entry/exits and other designated areas. Submission of construction documents to DCA is not required. The City of Camden will conduct all reviews.

1.3 Procurement Process and Schedule.

The selection of Qualified Respondents is not subject to the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq. The selection is subject to the "New Jersey Local Unit Pay-to-Play" Law, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq., however. The Parking Authority has structured a procurement process that seeks to obtain the desired results described above, while establishing a competitive process to assure that each person and/or firm is provided an equal opportunity to submit a Qualification Statement in response to the RFQ Qualification Statements will be evaluated in accordance with the criteria set forth in Section 5 of this RFQ, which will be applied in the same manner to each Qualification Statement received.

Qualification Statements will be reviewed and evaluated by the Parking Authority and its legal and/or financial advisors (collectively, the "Review Team"). The Qualification Statements will be reviewed to determine if the Respondent has met the minimum professional, administrative and financial areas described in this RFQ. Under no circumstances will a member of the review team review responses to an RFQ for a job which they or their firm submitted a response. Based upon the totality of the information contained in the Qualification Statement, including information about the reputation and experience of each Respondent, the Parking Authority will (in its sole judgment) determine which Respondents are qualified (from professional, administrative and financial standpoints) Each Respondent that meets the requirements of the RFQ (in the sole judgment of the Parking Authority) will be designated as a Qualified Respondent and will be given the opportunity to participate in the selection process determined by the Parking Authority.

The RFQ process commences with the issuance of this RFQ. The steps involved in the process and the anticipated completion dates are set forth in Table 1, Procurement Schedule. The Parking Authority reserves the right to, among other things, amend, modify or alter the Procurement Schedule upon notice to all

potential Respondents.

Subsequent to issuance of this RFQ, the Parking Authority (through the issuance of addenda to all firms that have received a copy of the RFQ) may modify, supplement or amend the provisions of this RFQ in order to respond to inquiries received from prospective Respondents or as otherwise deemed necessary or appropriate by (and in the sole judgment of) the Parking Authority.

1.4. Conditions Applicable to RFQ.

Upon submission of a Qualification Statement in response to this RFQ, the Respondent acknowledges and consents to the following conditions relative to the submission and review and consideration of its Qualification Statement:

- This document is an RFQ and does not constitute an RFP.
- This RFQ does not commit the Parking Authority to issue an RFP.
- All costs incurred by the Respondent in connection with responding to this RFQ shall be borne solely by the Respondent.
- The Parking Authority reserves the right (in its sole judgment) to reject for any reason any and all responses and components thereof and to eliminate any and all Respondents responding to this RFQ from further consideration for this procurement.
- The Parking Authority reserves the right (in its sole judgment) to reject any Respondent that submits incomplete responses to this RFQ, or a Qualification Statement that is not responsive to the requirements of this RFQ.
- The Parking Authority reserves the right, without prior notice, to supplement, amend, or otherwise modify this RFQ, or otherwise request additional information.
- All Qualification Statements shall become the property of the Parking Authority and will not be returned.
- All Qualification Statements will be made available to the public at the appropriate time, as determined by the Parking Authority (in the exercise of its sole discretion) in accordance with law.
- The Parking Authority may request Respondents to send representatives to the Parking Authority for interviews.
- Any and all Qualification Statements not received by the Parking Authority by 9:00 a.m. Prevailing Time on September 6, 2017 will be rejected.
- Neither the Parking Authority, nor their respective staffs, consultants or advisors (including but not limited to the Review Team) shall be liable for any claims or damages resulting from the solicitation or preparation of the Qualification Statement, nor will there be any reimbursement to Respondents for the cost of preparing and submitting a Qualification Statement or for participating in this procurement process.

1.5. Rights of Parking Authority.

The Parking Authority reserves, holds and may exercise, at its sole discretion, the following rights and options with regard to this RFQ and the procurement process in accordance with the provisions of applicable law:

- To determine that any Qualification Statement received complies or fails to comply with the terms of this RFQ.
- To supplement, amend or otherwise modify the RFQ through issuance of addenda to all prospective Respondents who have received a copy of this RFQ.
- To waive any technical non-conformance with the terms of this RFQ.
- To change or alter the schedule for any events called for in this RFQ upon the issuance of notice to all prospective Respondents who have received a copy of this RFQ.
- To conduct investigations of any or all of the Respondents, as the Parking Authority deems necessary or convenient, to clarify the information provided as part of the Qualification Statement and to request additional information to support the information included in any Qualification Statement.
- To suspend or terminate the procurement process described in this RFQ at any time (in its sole discretion.) If terminated, the Parking Authority may determine to commence a new procurement process or exercise any other rights provided under applicable law without any obligation to the Respondents.

The Parking Authority shall be under no obligation to complete all or any portion of the procurement process described in this RFQ.

1.6 Addenda or Amendments to RFQ.

During the period provided for the preparation of responses to the RFQ, the Parking Authority may issue addenda, amendments or answers to written inquiries. Those addenda will be noticed by the Parking Authority and will constitute a part of the RFQ. All responses to the RFQ shall be prepared with full consideration of the addenda issued prior to the proposal submission date.

1.7 Cost of Proposal Preparation.

Each proposal and all information required to be submitted pursuant to the RFQ shall be prepared at the sole cost and expense of the respondent. There shall be no

claims whatsoever against the Parking Authority, its staff or consultants for reimbursement for the payment of costs or expenses incurred in the preparation of the Qualification Statement or other information required by the RFQ.

1.8 Proposal Format.

Responses should cover all information requested in the Questions to be answered in this RFQ.

Responses which in the judgment of the Parking Authority fail to meet the requirements of the RFQ or which are in any way conditional, incomplete, obscure, contain additions or deletions from requested information, or contain errors may be rejected.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

It is the intent of the Parking Authority to solicit Qualification Statements from Respondents that have expertise in the provision of Parking Structure Geotechnical Engineering Services.

Firms and/or persons responding to this RFQ shall be able to demonstrate that they will have the continuing capabilities to perform all necessary services, including:

- 1. Exploratory & Subsurface Analysis
- 2. Borings
- 3. Analysis
- 4. Report Generation
- 5. Design Assistance During Design Process
- 6. Construction Administration Assistance

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Section 3.1 General Requirements.

The Qualification Statement submitted by the Respondent must meet or exceed the professional, administrative and financial qualifications set forth in this Section 3 and shall incorporate the information requested below.

In addition to the information required as described below, a Respondent may submit supplemental information that it feels may be useful in evaluating its Qualification Statement. Respondents are encouraged to be clear, factual, and concise in their presentation of information.

Section 3.2 <u>Administrative Information Requirements</u>.

The Respondent shall, as part of its Qualification Statement, provide the following information:

- 1. An executive summary (not to exceed two (2) pages) of the information contained in all the other parts of the Qualification Statement.
- 2. An executed Letter of Qualification (See Appendix A to this RFQ).
- 3. Name, address and telephone number of the firm or firms submitting the Qualification Statement pursuant to this RFQ, and the name of the key contact person.
- A description of the business organization (i.e., corporation, partnership, joint venture, etc.) of each firm, its ownership and its organizational structure.
 - a. Provide the names and <u>business</u> addresses of all Principals of the firm or firms submitting the Qualification Statement. For purposes of this RFQ, "Principals" means persons possessing an ownership interest in the Respondent. If the Respondent is a corporation, "Principals" shall include each investor who would have any amount of operational control over the Respondent and every stockholder having an ownership interest of 10% or more in the firm.
 - b. If a firm is a partially owned or a fully-owned subsidiary of another firm, identify the parent company and describe the nature and extent of the parents' approval rights over the activities of the firm submitting a Qualification Statement. Describe the approval process.
 - c. If the Respondent is a partnership or a joint venture or similar organization, provide comparable information as required in (b) above for each member of the partnership, joint venture or similar

- organization.
- d. A statement that the Respondent has complied with all applicable affirmative action (or similar) requirements with respect to its business activities, together with evidence of such compliance
- 5. An executed Letter of Intent (See Appendix B).
- 6. The number of years your organization has been in business under the present name.
- The number of years the business organization has been under the current management.
- 8. A statement that the Respondent is in compliance with all applicable affirmative action (or similar) requirements with respect to its business activities, together with evidence of such compliance.
- 9. Any judgments within the last three years in which Respondent has been adjudicated liable for professional malpractice. If yes, please explain.
- 10. Whether the business organization is now or has been involved in any bankruptcy or re-organization proceedings in the last ten (10) years. If yes, please explain.
- 11. Confirm appropriate federal and state licenses to perform activities.
- 12. Respondent shall submit contact information for 5 professional references. These individuals should be identified by client, with corresponding project name, physical address, phone number, and email address.

Section 3.3 <u>Professional Information Requirements</u>.

- Respondent shall submit a description of its overall experience in providing the type of services sought in the RFQ. At a minimum, the following information on past experience should be included as appropriate to the RFQ:
 - a. Description and scope of work by Respondent
 - b. Name, address and contact information of references
 - c. Explanation of perceived relevance of the experience to the RFQ
- 2. Describe the services that Respondent would perform directly.
- 3. Describe those portions of the Respondent's services, if any, that are subcontracted out. Identify all subcontractors the Respondent anticipates using in connection with this project.

- 4. Does the Respondent normally employ union or non-union employees?
- 5. Resumes of key employees
- 6. A narrative statement of the Respondent's understanding of the Parking Authority's needs and goals.
- 7. List all immediate relatives of Principal(s) of Respondent who are Parking Authority employees or elected officials of the City. For purposes of the above, "immediate relative" means a spouse, parent, stepparent, brother, sister, child, stepchild, direct-line aunt or uncle, grandparent, grandchild, and in-laws by reason of relation.

INSTRUCTIONS TO RESPONDENTS

4.1 <u>Submission of Qualification Statements.</u>

Qualification Statements must be received by the Parking Authority no later than 9:00 a.m. (prevailing time) on September 6, 2017, and must be mailed or hand-delivered. Qualification Statements forwarded by facsimile or e-mail will not be accepted. Qualification statements received after this time will not be considered. The Parking Authority will not bear responsibility for delays in delivery for any reason.

To be responsive, Qualification Statements must provide all requested information, and must be in strict conformance with the instructions set forth herein. Qualification Statements and all related information must be bound, and signed and acknowledged by the Respondent.

EVALUATION

The Parking Authority's objective in soliciting Qualification Statements is to enable it to select a firm or organization that will provide high quality and cost effective services to the citizens of Camden. The Parking Authority will consider Qualification Statements only from firms or organizations that, in the Parking Authority's judgment, have demonstrated the capability and willingness to provide high quality services to the citizens of the Parking Authority in the manner described in this RFQ.

Proposals will be evaluated by the Parking Authority on the basis of the most advantageous submission, all relevant factors considered. The evaluation will consider:

EVALUATION CRITERIA

- 1. <u>50 POINTS</u>: Experience and reputation providing Parking Structure Geotechnical Engineering Services.
- 2. <u>50 POINTS</u>: Experience providing Parking Structure Geotechnical Engineering Services to New Jersey Parking Authorities, Municipalities and Government entities.
