WHEREAS, pursuant to the Parking Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:11A-4(c), the Authority is authorized to acquire by gift, purchase, lease, devise, hold and use, and to construct, improve, maintain, operate, own, manage, or lease either in a capacity of lessor or lessee, parking projects of any land, franchise, property, real, personal or mixed, tangible or intangible; and

WHEREAS, the Parking Authority of the City of Camden of Camden ("PACC") is considering entering into a Site License Agreement (the "Agreement") with the New Jersey Economic Development Authority ("NJEDA") to assist with additional parking needs; and

WHEREAS, the NJEDA has the right to use certain property located at Block 79, Lot 13 (the "Premises"); and

WHEREAS, the NJEDA is willing to permit the PACC exclusive access and use of the Premises for the purpose of providing additional parking for the patrons of BB&T Pavilion for 2019 Event Days and other Camden Waterfront events, upon the terms and conditions as more specifically set forth in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the term of this Agreement for the Premises will be available to PACC for the purposes set forth herein from January 1, 2019 through October 31, 2019, which period can be extended or renewed at the sole discretion of the NJEDA for one additional year term;

WHEREAS, during the term of this Agreement, the PACC agrees to pay rent to the NJEDA in the amount of 20% of all parking revenue collected by the PACC in connection with its use of the Premises, said sums to be paid monthly without demand, commencing April 1, 2019;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Commissioners of the PACC hereby authorizes the execution of a Site License Agreement with the NJEDA for the purposes contained herein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, including the Site License Agreement, subject to final review by General Counsel as to legal form and content.
