WHEREAS, the Parking Authority of the City of Camden ("Authority") is a public corporation established by declaration of necessity by the legislature in the Parking Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:11A-1 et seq. for the public purpose to promote the public safety convenience welfare and the necessity in the public interest for the provision of public parking; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is vested with all powers necessary or convenient to carry out and effectuate its corporate purpose of the construction, provision or operation of off-street parking projects within its area of operation; and

WHEREAS, the Authority relies upon elevator service in the Hinson Garage to provide parking accommodations consistent with the American with Disabilities Act; and

WHEREAS, there existed for the Authority the need for the services of a qualified firm to provide repair services for elevators in the Hinson Parking Garage operated by the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's consulting engineer investigated the conditions of the Hinson Parking Garage elevators and made findings in a February 10, 2020 opinion letter that "one elevator is currently out of service and in need of significant control, car, power, communication, and ADA updates and modernization"; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's consulting engineer made additional findings with regard to the second elevator that "identical to the first elevator, has been exhibiting similar operational symptoms as the one currently out of service and has been generally unreliable over the past two months"; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's consulting engineer concluded that the modernization of both elevators should be deemed as "emergency repair" based on the complexity of the project, how the overall systems work in unison, and the new/current code requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Camden County Improvement Authority ("CCIA") is the Project Manager for the Hinson Garage Elevator Repairs through an interlocal services agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Authority and the CCIA seek to extend the interlocal services agreement to see the Project to completion; and

WHEREAS, the CCIA has provided a proposal for a 10 week extension for Project Manager services in an amount not to exceed \$8,240.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioner of the Parking Authority of the City of Camden as follows:

- 1. The Commissioners of the Parking Authority of the City of Camden authorize a limited extension of an interlocal services agreement with CCIA for Project Manager Services to complete the Hinson Garage Elevator Repairs.

WHEREAS, based on the review of these items and information, the Committee makes a recommendation to re-new the contract of Mr. Hunter for an additional five-year term on substantially the same terms and conditions of the current contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioner of the Parking Authority of the City of Camden as follows:

- 1.
