RESOLUTION OF

THE PARKING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF CAMDEN AMENDING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR PARKING LOT UPGRADE CONCEPT PLAN AND COST ESTIMATES

WHEREAS, the Parking Authority of the City of Camden ("Authority") is a public corporation established by declaration of necessity by the legislature in the Parking Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:11A-1 et seq. for the public purpose to promote the public safety convenience welfare and the necessity in the public interest for the provision of public parking; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is vested with all powers necessary or convenient to carry out and effectuate its corporate purpose of the construction, provision or operation of offstreet parking projects within its area of operation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Parking Authorities Law, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40:11A-6(3) the Authority is authorized to plan, design, construct, reconstruct, enlarge, improve, manage, maintain, repair, operate and use such parking project or projects as in the opinion of the authority will provide an effective and satisfactory method for promoting the purposes of the authority; and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to see options, concept plans, and budgets for renovations to parking lots 30 & 31 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, to complete the Project design and budget work beyond is required; and

WHEREAS, Pennoni provided a proposal for an additional scope of work for the Project in the amount of \$5,455.00; and

WHEREAS, on January 2021, the Board of Commissioners resolved to qualify Pennoni as a qualified engineering firm and the Authority has previously retained said firm based on a Fair and Open procurement process for Professional Services; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) and Pay to Play Law requires that resolutions authorizing the award of contracts for "Professional Services" without competitive bids must be publicly advertised; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioner of the Parking Authority of the City of Camden as follows:

- 1. The Commissioners of the Parking Authority of the City of Camden authorize the Executive Director to enter into an amended professional services contract with Pennoni, a Licensed Engineering Firm, located at 2 Aquarium Drive, Camden, New Jersey 08103 for additional scope of work for Lot 30 & 31 concept plans, which shall remain on file in the Authority's office and available for public inspection.
- 2. This total award of the amended contract shall not exceed \$5,455.00.
- This agreement is awarded without competitive bidding as a "Professional Service" under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5) because it is a recognized profession, licensed and regulated by law.
- 4. A notice of this action shall be printed in the Legal Newspaper of the Authority as required by law within ten (10) days of its passage.
- The vendor shall supply the Agency with the Federal Affirmative Action Plan Approval or State Certificate of Employee Information Report within the time period specified by N.J.A.C. 17:27. The contract shall contain the mandatory affirmative language for professional services contracts required by N.J.A.C. 17:27, a copy of which shall be attached to and incorporated in the professional services contract authorized herein.
- The vendor shall agree to comply with the requirements of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and indemnify, protect and save harmless the Agency from all suits, claims, losses, demands or damages of whatever kind or nature arising out of or claimed to arise out of alleged violations of the Act. A copy of the Act shall be attached to and incorporated in the professional services agreement authorized herein.
- 7. The engineering services and construction work will be paid from the dedicated capital expenditure fund for waterfront parking improvements.
