

THE PARKING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF CAMDEN AUTHORIZING THE PARKING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF CAMDEN TO ENTER INTO A MUNICIPAL SUBSCRIPTION TO COLLECTIVE PROCUREMENT CONTRACT WITH EDUCATIONAL SERVICES COMMISSION OF NEW JERSEY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE A COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5) authorizes contracting units to establish a Cooperative Pricing System and to enter into Cooperative Pricing Agreements for its administration; and

WHEREAS, the Educational Services Commission of New Jersey, hereinafter referred to as the "Lead Agency " has offered voluntary participation in a Cooperative Pricing System for the purchase of goods and services;

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Parking Authority of the City of Camden, County of Camden, State of New Jersey duly considered participation in a Cooperative Pricing System for the provision and performance of goods and services;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

TITLE

This RESOLUTION shall be known and may be cited as the Cooperative Pricing Resolution of the Parking Authority of the City of Camden

AUTHORITY

Pursuant to the provisions of *N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5)*, the Executive Director is hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperative Pricing Agreement with the Lead Agency.

CONTRACTING UNIT

The Lead Agency shall be responsible for complying with the provisions of the *Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.)* and all other provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey.



RESOLUTION ***OF***

THE PARKING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF CAMDEN AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH WINDSTREAM ENTERPRISE FOR PHONE SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Parking Authority of the City of Camden (“Authority”) is a public corporation established by declaration of necessity by the legislature in the Parking Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:11A-1 et seq. for the public purpose to promote the public safety convenience welfare and the necessity in the public interest for the provision of public parking; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is vested with all powers necessary or convenient to carry out and effectuate its corporate purpose of the construction, provision or operation of offstreet parking projects within its area of operation; and

WHEREAS, there existed for the Authority the need for the services of a qualified firm to provide phone services for the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Authority currently has phone services from Windstream Enterprise and wishes to extend the service on the same terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioner of the Parking Authority of the City of Camden as follows:

1. The Commissioners of the Parking Authority of the City of Camden authorize an extension of the service agreement with Windstream Enterprise, PO Box 3177, Cedar Rapids, IA 52406-3177.
2. This amount is awarded without competitive bidding the services are provided through a master contract awarded to national cooperative purchasing contract.


