

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to eliminate the requirement for claimant certifications for all vendors with the following exception, the advance or reimbursement of employee expenses, or for services provided exclusively and entirely by an individual, including sole proprietors.



WHEREAS, the Authority has an Employment Agreement with Willie Hunter as Executive Director of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Employment Agreement requires the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners to evaluate the performance of the Executive Director on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, the Employment Agreement provides for annual salary increases based on acceptable job performance upon evaluation by the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director deferred any salary increase for 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners evaluated the performance of the Executive Director and found that the Executive Director’s performance for the 2022 calendar year was exceptional based on specific findings including the fiscal performance of the Authority exceeding budgeted revenue and operating expenses below budget; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners evaluated the performance of the Executive Director and found that the Executive Director’s performance for the 2022 calendar year was exceptional based on specific findings including maximizing available revenue sources and cutting costs as parking demand was lost due to the COVID-19 pandemic and quarantine in Camden; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman conducted the annual review and determined that the performance was exceptional, that additional duties will be placed upon the Executive Director in 2023 and beyond and that the Executive Director’s salary was significantly

below market when compared to the salaries of executive directors at similarly sized Parking Authorities in the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, as part of the annual review the Chairman recommends a salary adjustment of \$15,000 increase for the Executive Director to adequately compensate him for his job duties and performance;

WHEREAS, the Chairman recommends an annual raise of 5% above the Executive Director's adjusted salary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioner of the Parking Authority of the City of Camden as follows:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Camden adopted Ordinance MC-5288 on October 10, 2020 amending Ordinance MC-38 relating to traffic and regulating the use of streets and highways in the City of Camden (the “Ordinance”); and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance provides for an adjustment to on-street parking meter rates; and

WHEREAS, the Authority seeks to increase on-street meter rates for the first time since implementation of the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has evaluated on-street parking rates in other municipalities in New Jersey and finds the Camden on-street parking rates are below market; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Parking Authority of the City of Camden that the on-street meter rate shall be increased uniformly throughout the City of Camden from \$1.00 per hour to \$1.25 per hour; and


